WHEREAS, concomitant to the cited noble objective, the Provincial Board in a duly convened session and through the ardent desire and fervent hope and expectancy for the preservation of the cited historical landmarks, through the relentless efforts of the SP Committee on Tourism chaired by Hon. Aristotle J. Gaza jointly with the members of the Provincial Board vigorously moved and approved to enact the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 02 Series of 2015

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE BATAAN HISTORICAL COUNCIL, DEFINING ITS ROLES, POWERS, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS, PROVIDING GUIDELINES AND POLICIES THEREOF, STATING ITS COMPOSITIONS AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

Section I. CREATION OF HISTORICAL COUNCIL - This Ordinance hereby creates the Bataan Historical Council.

Section II. COMPOSITION – The Bataan Historical Council as created is hereby composed of the following:

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES OF THE BHC, Section III. OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "BATAAN HISTORICAL COUNCIL".

- To give importance on the historical sites, monuments, 1. shrines, and markers in the province;
- To create historical awareness and patriotism to the 2. Bataeños, especially to the youth and the next generation;
- 3. To broaden the knowledge and awareness about research and publication in terms of history, arts and culture of Bataan;
- 4. To provide policies and guidelines for the maintenance, preservation and protection of articles covered by this Ordinance;

5. Act as umbrella agency of all local historical councils in the different municipalities/city.

Section IV. HISTORICAL, RESEARCH, TASKS AND FUNCTIONS – The Council is further clothed with authority to prepare programs and provide policies for the effective implementations of the programs and objective stated in this Ordinance which shall include but not limited to the following:

- To conduct an inventory of the existing landmarks in the Province and to further validate its historical significance;
- To properly identify places, landmarks, monuments, documents, objects, peoples, artifacts, paraphernalia's and the likes which are deemed of historical, cultural and for other significant value;
- Act as effective liaison with line agencies of the government and private entities in collecting data, information's, necessary for the protection, maintenance and care of landmarks, places and artifacts of historical value and significance;
- Promote and encourage the effective participation of all sectors in the province in the advertisement, protection and care of places and landmarks of cultural and historical value; and
- Consolidate books, records, writings, notes, and other documents of cultural and historical significance;
- Enunciate the necessary procedure for the inclusion of the history of Bataan Province in the curriculum of primary education;
- 7. Set commemorative activities to celebrate historical events, with national significance in the province;
- Formulate measures and provide information's, researches and data's which will aid the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and the Provincial Governor in policy making necessary for the effective implementation of this Ordinance;
- Be responsible for the management of records and archival of documents including its authentication, custody and be accountable to the same;
- 10. To seek the assistance of concerned agencies of the local and national government and various sector including religious groups and associations for the effective implementation of objectives stated in this Ordinance; and

11. Perform such other duties and functions necessary for effective implementation of this Ordinance.

Section V. MEETINGS – The Council shall hold a monthly meeting or any other times as maybe necessary, and a general meeting once a year.

Section VI. APPROPRIATIONS – This ordinance further provides the necessary funds as maybe appropriated by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members and that the expenditures thereof shall be subject to regular accounting and auditing procedures.

Section VII. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason or reasons, any part or provisions of this Ordinance shall held to be invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section VIII. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE – This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
