WHEREAS, Section 468 (a) (1) (viii) of the same Code provides that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan is empowered to determine the positions and salaries, including allowances and other emoluments and benefits of the employees of the provincial government;

WHEREAS, the transfer of offices and plantilla positions from the Bataan Youth Development Office (BYDO) and Cultural Heritage Preservation Division (CHPD) under the Office of the Provincial Governor to the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) and Provincial Tourism Office (PTO), respectively, will be more efficient for more streamlined operations and functions of the involved offices;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF BATAAN, IN REGULAR SESSION, DULY ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 2. The employment of the personnel involved in the transfer of positions to other offices shall be deemed transferred to their new offices without reduction of salaries and other benefits and without losing their salary grades and the plantilla positions they occupy.

SECTION 3. The salaries and benefits of the transferred employees shall be appropriated in their new office assignments to be incorporated in the Annual Budget or Supplemental Budget of the Provincial Government of Bataan.

SECTION 5. Effectivity. - The Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


