PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 04 Series of 2023

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BATAAN HISTORY WALL.

AUTHORED AND SPONSORED BY:

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 15 of the Philippine Constitution mandates the state to "conserve, promote, and popularize the nation's historical and cultural heritage";

WHEREAS, Section 468 of the Local Government Code provides for the creation of local cultural and historical committees, thus manifesting its intent to cause the preservation and promotion of cultural and historical heritage of respective communities;

WHEREAS, the Bataan History Wall can prove to be an important tool and vehicle for preserving legislative history and heritage, deepening Bataeños' understanding of the importance thereof by creating a connection to the past, educating future generations, and preserving the memory of important events and people;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Bataan History Wall Ordinance".

Section 2. Purpose. – The Bataan History Wall will serve as a visual representation of and tangible connection to the rich history and legacy of the Provincial Government of Bataan and its officials. It intends to educate the public and future generations about the role and contributions thereo`f in local and national governance. It is hoped that it will serve as a source of pride and inspiration for Bataeños, especially the youth of the province.

Section 3. Establishment of the Bataan History Wall. - A history wall shall be established inside the session hall of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan or at any appropriate location inside the Provincial Capitol Building (The Bunker) of the Province of Bataan, as may be subsequently determined.

Section 4. Contents of the Bataan History Wall. - The Bataan History Wall shall contain the following:

- a. A list of all past and present members of Congress who are Bataeños, including their positions, municipality/city of origin, term of office and other relevant data;
- A list of Governors and Vice Governors of the Province of Bataan, including their municipality/city of origin, term of office and other relevant data;
- c. A brief history of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Bataan and its role in the governance of the province;
- d. A list of all past and present members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, including their municipality/city of origin, terms of office and other relevant data;
- e. Important information, milestones, contributions and other data relevant to the Provincial Government of Bataan;
- f. Relevant memorabilia, mementos and souvenirs;
- g. Any other relevant information deemed necessary by the Governor or Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

Section 5. Appropriation. - The amount necessary to implement this Ordinance shall be sourced from the relevant items in the Annual Appropriation Ordinance and/or Supplemental Appropriation Ordinances, as may be necessary.

Section 6. Implementing Offices. – The office of the Secretary of the SP and the Cultural and Heritage Preservation Division shall be the primary implementing offices of this Ordinance. As such, they will be responsible for putting up the Bataan History Wall and the periodic maintenance of the same.

The Cultural and Heritage Preservation Division shall be responsible for the curation of the information, items and other exhibits that will form part of the Bataan History Wall. It shall ensure that the information contained thereon are accurate.

Section 7. Promotion of the Bataan History Wall. - The Cultural and Heritage Division, Provincial Tourism Office and the Provincial Information Office shall make sure that Bataeños and tourists are made aware of the existence of the Bataan History Wall so that its full potential, value and use may be maximized.

Section 8. Separability Clause. - If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 9. Repealing Clause. - All ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders or administrative regulations which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 10. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect after compliance with the relevant provisions of the Local Government Code on posting and publication.
