Sir:-

In accordance with the provisions of sections 574, 575, and 2087 of the Revised Administrative Code, I have the honor to submit to you the following report for the fiscal year which terminated on December 31, 1917:

PROVINCIAL ADMINISTRATION.

The government of the Province of Bataan has within its scope eleven municipalities, the same number of pueblos or towns under the Spanish regime. During the previous three years this number has been reduced to ten, due to the consolidation in 1914 of the municipalities of Dinalupihan and Hermosa into one municipality under the name of Bagumbayan. But by the segregation of the former barrio of Limay from Orion and its organization into an independent municipality the number of municipalities in the Province of Bataan reached again to eleven in 1917.

The consolidation of the former municipalities of Hermosa and Dinalupihan has proved to be a failure. On account of this consolidation the seat of the new municipal government has been established in a solitary place, the place selected for this purpose, almost halfway be-
