PERMIT TO EXTRACT, TAKE, REMOVE, UTILIZE AND DISPOSE QUARRY MATERIALS FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES

After full compliance with the requirements of the Application for Quarry Permit filed at the Environment and Natural Resources Office (ENRO) and the amendment of its existing Quarry Permit (No. OP-B-21-003) through PMRB Resolution No. 1, Series of 2024 duly approved by the members of the Provincial Mining Regulatory Board (PMRB). This Quarry Permit (QP) assigned as QP-B-21-003-a is hereby granted to extract, take, remove and commercially dispose Fifty thousand metric tons (50,000 MT) of filling materials and other quarry resources authorized under the Local Government Code (RA 7160), the Philippine Mining Act of 1995 (RA 7942), other laws, decrees, ordinances, rules and regulations from the permit area situated in Barangay, Parang, Bagac, Province of Bataan in the island of Luzon, Philippines covering an area approximately 4.93 hectares and more particularly described as follows:

The amended terms and conditions of this Quarry Permit are as follows:

This Ouarry Permit is valid for a period of five (5) years or from August 07, 2024 1. to August 07, 2029 renewable for the same period but not exceeding twenty-five (25) years upon the filing of the application for renewal before the expiry date; provided that the Permittee shall not have been guilty of any violation of this Permit's terms and conditions, and that the Permittee has complied with the provisions of pertinent laws, ordinances, rules and regulations;
