PERMIT TO EXTRACT, TAKE, REMOVE, UTILIZE AND DISPOSE QUARRY MATERIALS FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES

After full compliance with the requirements for Small-Scale Quarry Permit Application filed by Mr. Leonardo B. David III at the Provincial Government Environment and Natural Resources Office (PG-ENRO), and the approval of Resolution No. 4, series of 2023 by the members of Provincial Mining Regulatory Board (PMRB) of Bataan, this Quarry Permit (QP), denominated as QP-B-23-001, is hereby granted to extract, take, remove and commercially dispose filling materials and other quarry resources not exceeding FIFTY THOUSAND METRIC TONS (50,000 MT) annually as authorized under the RA 7160 "Local Government Code" and RA 7942 "the Philippine Mining Act of 1995" and other relevant laws, decrees, ordinances, and implementing rules and regulations from the permit area situated in Barangay Dangcol, Balanga City, Province of Bataan. The project area covers a total land area of approximately 5 HECTARES and more particularly described as follows:
